The included colors are black, electric blue, intense green, neon yellow, heatwave (light orange), octane orange (bright orange), & 2 shades of grey. As usual, the quilt is to be 20" by 20", and the quilter may use any technique and/or embellishments, but NO other colors or fabrics. Lastly, the 2022 Challenge is entitled, "Graffiti".
